“Hanawarabe” was formed in 2000 by Kasei Nakamura(中村 花誠), who is active as a Japanese music performer, mainly elementary and high school girls in Kumamoto Prefecture. They are in high demand as they hold over 250 performances at various events in and outside of Kumamoto. They have also traveled overseas for the performances, such as Seoul, South Korea and Shanghai, China.

Regular dance performances by “Hanawarabe” have been held in Amakusa Shiro Museum with the theme of “Shiro Amakusa” and the “Battle of Amakusa-Shimabara”. It is a creative dance performance expressing the sufferings and the preciousness of love of the people of Amakusa area during the times of Christian prohibition in Japan.
